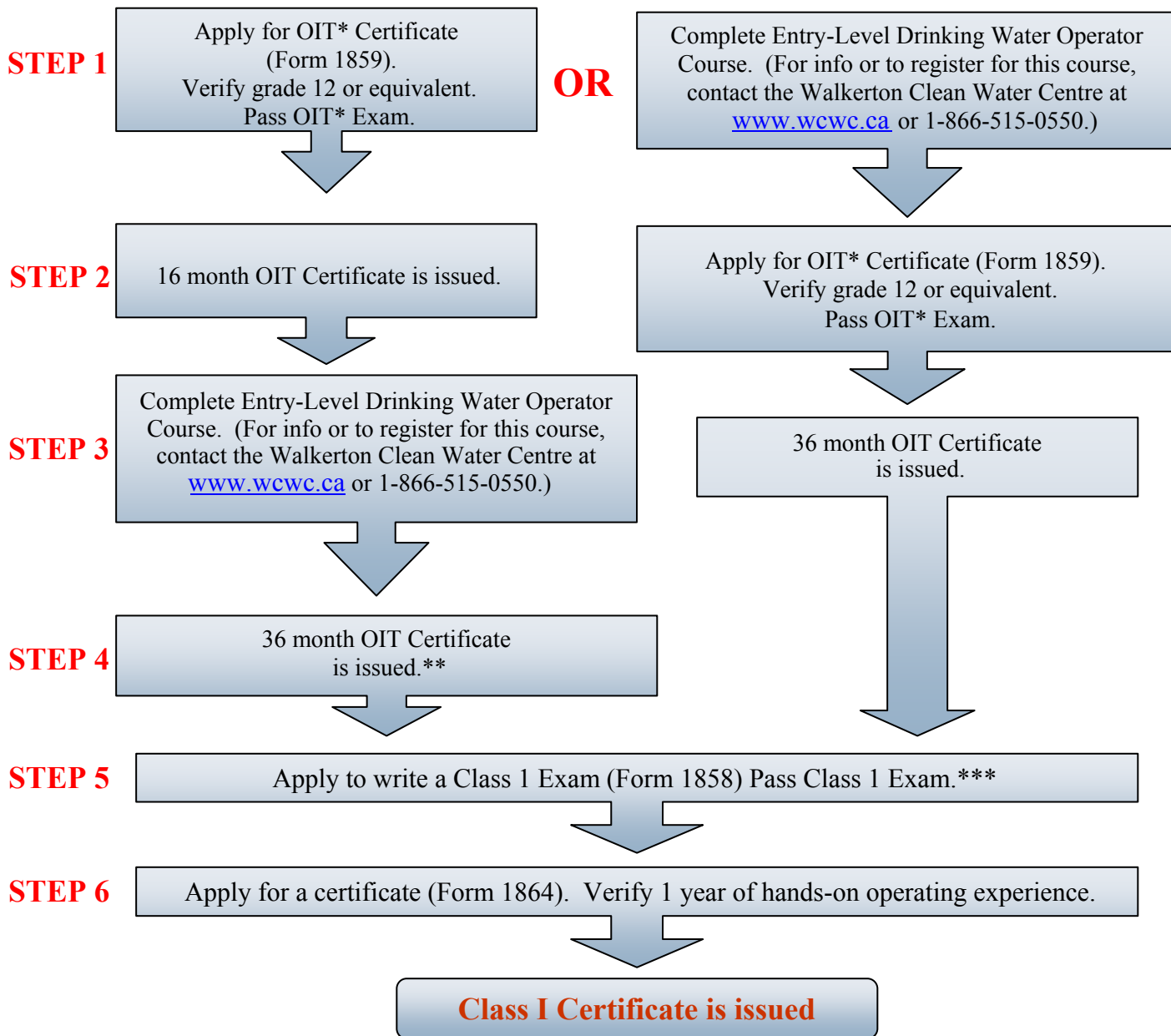


Steps To Become a Class 1 Drinking Water System Operator

Ontario Regulations 170/03 and 128/04 require all persons operating a large municipal residential or small municipal residential system (surface water) to hold a Class 1 to 4 or Operator-in-Training (OIT) certificate. Forms are available at www.owwco.ca.



* May write Class 1 Exam rather than OIT exam in Step 1 or 2.
 ** 36 months from original issue date of OIT certificate.
 *** Step 4 is omitted if Class 1 exam was written in Step 1 or 2.
